Dear USAID Reviewers,

On behalf of Cultural Agents, an Initiative at Harvard University and also an independent NGO, I write to express strong support for the Development Institute's (ID) proposal and our interest in being part of the higher education consortium and the proposed solution.

The Harvard Cultural Agents Initiative began with the new millennium, in the 2000, as a network of academics, artists, educators, and organizations who develop the arts and humanities as resources for positive change. The term "Cultural Agents" emerged from a number of successful conferences and corollary programs developed in response to a challenge posed by the Social Science Research Council: to design arts-based projects that would engage social scientists and individuals concerned with the political and material well-being of underserved populations. This challenge led to explorations of notable creative practices in Latin America and beyond in collaboration with the Hemispheric Institute at NYU, the David Rockefeller Center for Latin American Studies at Harvard University, the Harvard Graduate School of Education, Department of African American Studies, English, and East Asian Studies at Harvard University. The Cultural Agents Initiative has sought to increase the impact of creative and scholarly practices by identifying artists, educators, and community leaders who have developed socially productive practices, by reflecting on the role of art in building civil society, and by disseminating best practices through workshops and public forums.

Given the challenges, solutions and audiences described in the proposal, there are several potential roles for Cultural Agents. Our Pre-Texts pedagogy ([www.pre-texts.org](http://www.pre-texts.org)), recognized by UNESCO as "Education for Peace" in Colombia would serve well as a training platform to establish a culture of accountability and creativity across Paraguayan society, starting with courts of law. It has been implemented by human rights lawyers and can generally be used to build capacity in transparency and fairness. The training stimulates a culture of recognition and admiration for fellow citizens. Our content can be adapted to fit the cultural context of Paraguay, forming a foundation for trainings, workshops and exchanges for a range of participants and focusing, at an initial stage, on practitioners of the law.

The Institute has a long tradition of inspiring peer institutions in higher education to create co-curricular centers dedicated to attracting the next generation of young people to civic and political life. Universities such as the University of Chicago and Georgetown University have created Institutes of Politics inspired in our model.
